



Rotary Club of Lancaster Community Service Awards Criteria

Youth Award

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Nominee is an 11th or 12th grade student
- Nominee is a student at Lancaster Catholic, Lancaster Country Day or McCaskey high schools, or is home-schooled or a cyber-school student connected to one of these schools

SELECTION CRITERIA

The emphasis for award selection is on impactful and meaningful volunteer service that fosters community well-being in Lancaster County, preferably in Lancaster City. There is no minimum GPA requirement.

LETTERS OF SUPPORT

Letter of support should discuss the following aspects of the nominee's community service:

- Contributions to strengthening the community through volunteer service (describe the activity, history of nominee's community activities, major accomplishments);
- Special leadership qualities (ability to inspire and encourage others);
- Ability to achieve outcomes (such as problems solved, numbers of people reached, measurable change, dollars saved or raised); and
- Any extraordinary effort made by the nominee, and any challenges or obstacles that were overcome in making these contributions.

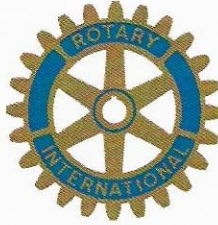
NOMINATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

- The Lancaster Catholic, Lancaster County Day and McCaskey high schools are each invited to nominate one or more candidates for the committee's consideration.
- Lancaster Rotary members may nominate a student from any of the above schools or one connected to one of these schools as a home school or cyber-school student.
- The Lancaster Rotary Community Service Award Committee (CSAC) makes the final selection of up to four awardees.

RECOGNITION

- Each awardee will be recognized at a Rotary Club of Lancaster luncheon, receive a cash gift of \$100, and have the opportunity to designate a Rotary check of \$100 to a favorite charity.
